Facts

- Hair loss usually sets in between the ages of 20 and 30 years. First symptoms are thinning and loss of the hair in the parietal, frontal and temporal areas.
- In case of an androgenetic alopecia, hair loss is irreversible.

Who and when should be tested?

- Men and women between the ages of 20 and 30 years with family history of androgenetic alopecia, preferably before the onset of any symptoms.

Why ALOPECIAgen?

- Easy to carry out and innovative
- Prevention is the only possibility to delay or to stop the premature development of androgenetic alopecia.
- ALOPECIAgen demonstrates a distinction of three different alopecia risk groups.

Results and Interpretation

- based on the risk group and the gender of the patient, ALOPECIAgen allows determining whether a minoxidil and/or finasteride treatment will be beneficial.
- Provided nutrigenetic and lifestyle recommendations in the ALOPECIAgen contribute to the prevention of androgenetic alopecia.

Additional Information

- Since ALOPECIAgen is a genetic analysis, it needs to be carried out only once in a lifetime.
- Required sample material is either a blood sample or a saliva sample.



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
